

Add-on Course on ‘Pedagogic Theatre’

Pedagogic theatre combines critical thinking, artistic-pedagogical practices and exploration of the wide range of meanings in the arts.

Objectives

On completion of the course, the prospective teachers would be able to:

- develop and understanding of drama and art, the scope, and purpose of art education and art as the basis of education
- exhibit basic understanding in art appreciation, art expression, and art education
- explore the adaptive strategies of artistic expression in classroom learning
- explore the role of the teacher as a creative guide in learning that is drama driven
- explore how art and drama can enhance learning

Range of art activities in drama, Experiencing, responding and appreciating the drama, Exposure to selective basic skills required for drama, Drama: Facilitating interest among students: planning and implementing activities, Enhancing learning through drama for children with and without special needs: strategies and adaptations.
