The meeting began with a silent prayer. Principal, Dr. Varghese K. Cheriyan welcomed the members.

The committee appreciated the efforts taken by all the stakeholders in organising the Diamond Jubilee celebration of the college on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2017 in a befitting manner.

The committee appreciated the infrastructure development activities undertaken. The completion of the retaining wall in the backyard and completion of the first stage of construction of the Indoor stadium was specially noted.

The committee reviewed the plan of action for the academic year 2017-18 and put forward suggestions for the successful implementation of the same.

It was decided to strengthen ICT based teaching - learning processes, especially use of blogs and online submission of learning materials.

It was decided to implement the add on courses on theatre arts and computer proficiency. Dr.Jisha Baby and Dr. Ronu Thomas were selected as the coordinators of the courses, respectively.

The members suggested introducing a course in English language for the students to help them enhance their career prospects with Mrs. Latha Joseph as the coordinator.

The IQAC decided to conduct Académic Audit both externally and internally. It was decided to conduct an internal academic audit under the leadership of IQAC in the month of March. Since there is an academic evaluation of students of both B. Ed and M. Ed by an external body assigned by the University, it was decided to consider it as an external academic audit.

As part of Diamond Jubilee celebrations two of our B. Ed students released a documentary on drug abuse, which they developed under the guidance of Mrs.Praveena Gopinath. The members suggested sharing of the documentary to teaching practice schools during school internship, for the benefit of school students.

Since qualifying in competitive exams like KTET and CTET is declared mandatory for the appointment of teachers, the members suggested encouraging the students for the same. It was decided to motivate studentspersonally during mentoring andto share relevant information with them.

It was decided to jointly celebrate the FOSSA day and Jubilarians' day on the second Saturday of December, 2017. It was decided to invite all the members of FOSSA, especially students who passed out from the college during the last three years and alumni of 1992-93 and 1967-68 batches for the same.
